

# Read Naturally SE 2.0.3 Update Macintosh Stand-Alone Installation Instructions (Mac OS X and Mac OS 9)

This document explains how to apply the Read Naturally Software Edition 2.0.3 update to existing installations of SE version 2.0, 2.0.1, and 2.0.2.

**Important:** It is very important that you backup your data before updating. This is an **essential** step and is your only insurance should something go wrong.

## To back up your data:

1. Start SE database utilities (rnse\_DBUtilities.exe) from the following location.

**Mac OS X - /Applications/Read Naturally SE 2/**

**Mac OS 9 - /Applications (Mac OS 9)/Read Naturally SE 2/**

2. From the **Backup/Restore** tab, click **Create Backup**, and then click **Continue**.
3. Browse to the folder where you want to save the backup file, select the folder, and then click **OK**.
4. When the backup is finished, click **OK**.
5. Click **Quit** to close the database utilities.

## To update Mac OS X stand-alone installations:

1. Download the installation file **rnse\_203\_OSX\_sa.dmg** from the following web page to the Mac OS X computer:

2. Locate the downloaded file on your computer and double-click it. This extracts a volume entitled **rnse\_203\_OSX\_sa**. If needed, double-click the volume to open it.
3. Double-click **RNSA\_203\_Mac-X** to start the upgrade. The Mac OS Authenticate screen displays. Enter the appropriate Mac OS administrator user ID and password, and then click **OK**



4. The Introduction screen displays. Click **Continue**.



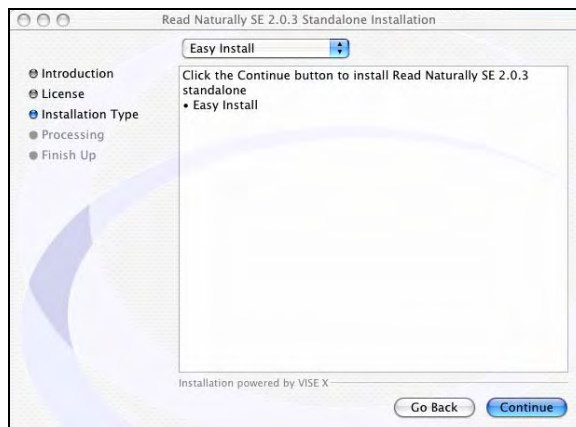
5. The license agreement displays. Read the license agreement (you can click **Print** to print it), and then click **Continue** to continue with the upgrade.



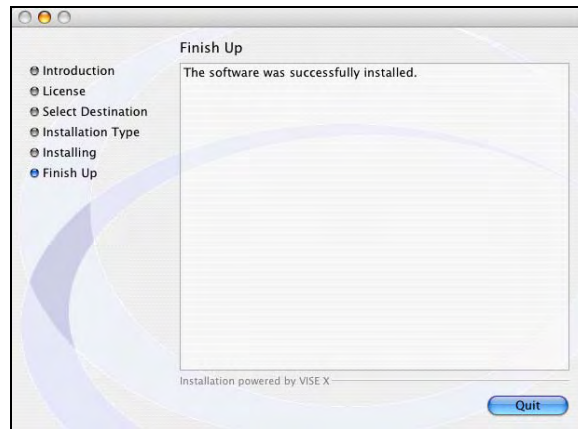
6. To continue the upgrade, you must **Agree** with the terms of the license agreement.



7. The Read Naturally SE 2.0.3 updater automatically locates the existing SE files. Click **Continue** to start the upgrade. A bar shows the installation progress.

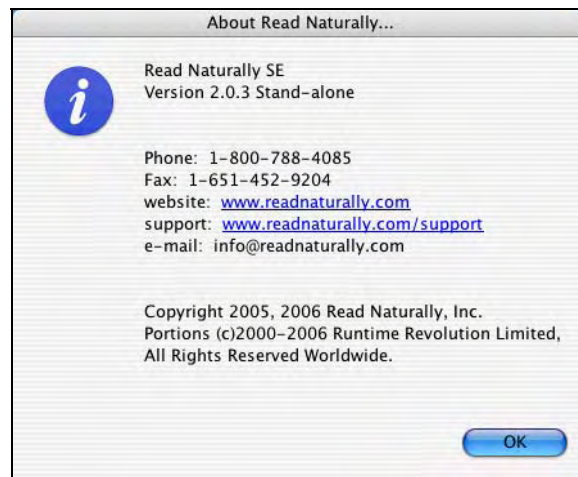


8. When the update finishes, click **Quit**.



9. Perform the following steps to confirm that the SE software has been updated:

- a. Start Read Naturally SE. The login screen displays.
- b. Choose **About Read Naturally** from the Read Naturally SE menu.



- c. Confirm that the SE version shown is **Version 2.0.3 Stand-alone**.
- d. Click **OK** to close the About window, and then click **Exit** to close the login screen.

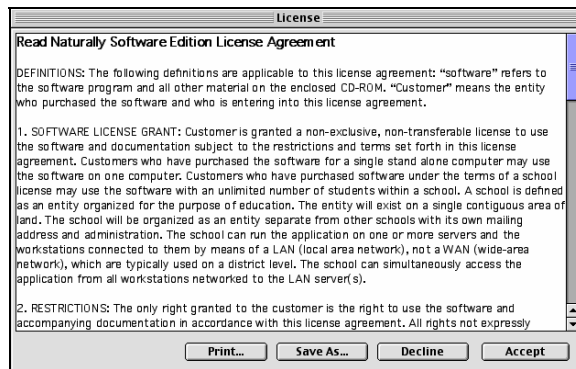
#### To update Mac OS 9 stand-alone installations:

1. Download the installation file **rnse\_203\_OS9\_sa.img.bin** from the following web page to the Mac OS 9 computer:  

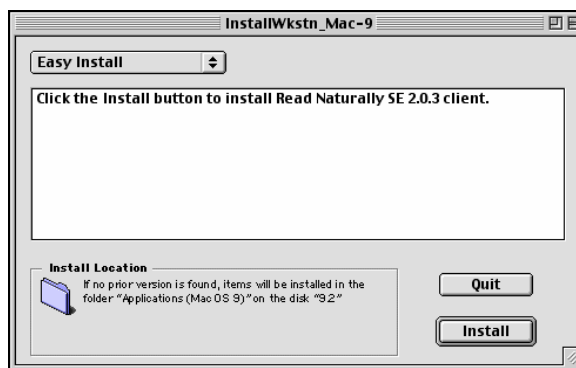

2. Locate the downloaded file on your computer and double-click it. This extracts the installer file entitled **rnse\_203\_OS9\_sa**. Double-click **RNSA\_203\_Mac-9** to start the upgrade. The Read Naturally SE 2.0.3 Setup screen displays. Click **Continue**.



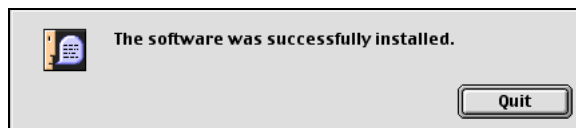
3. The license agreement displays. Read the license agreement (you can click **Print** to print it), and then click **Accept** to continue with the upgrade.



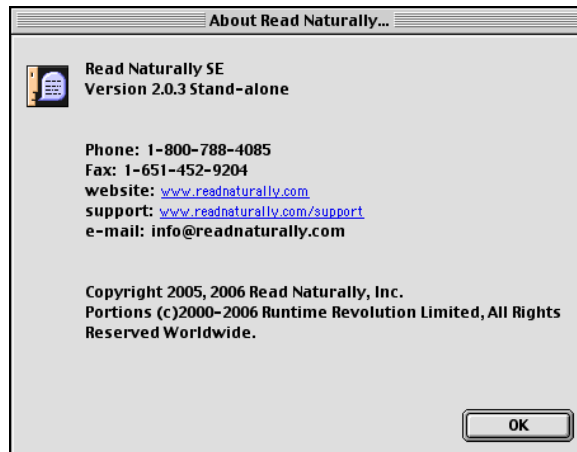
4. The Read Naturally SE 2.0.3 updater automatically locates the existing SE files. Click **Install** to begin installing the software upgrade.



5. When the update finishes, click **Quit**.



6. Perform the following steps to confirm that the SE software has been updated:
  - a. Start Read Naturally SE. The login screen displays.
  - b. Choose **About Read Naturally** from the Apple menu.



- c. Confirm that the SE version shown is **Version 2.0.3 Stand-alone**.
- d. Click **OK** to close the About window, and then click **Exit** to close the login screen.
