

- 8 the people who live in a region


DOWN

- 9** able to be used for a long time without wearing out


DOWN

- 9 eats or drinks


DOWN

- 9 a guess made after careful watching and thinking


DOWN

- 9 the reason for something


DOWN

- 9 objects that stand for something other than themselves


DOWN

- 10 forceful, bold, or ready to fight hard for something


DOWN

- 9 dedicated


DOWN

- 10 unpleasant or disagreeable


DOWN


DOWN

- 8 a tower with a strong light on top to guide ships and warn them of danger


DOWN

- 9 short, stiff hairs


DOWN

- 9** materials that can harm the body


DOWN

- 9 able to cause sickness or death, especially by poison


DOWN

- 8** bad feelings between people that can lead to mistrust


DOWN

- 9 small arrows with sharp points


DOWN

- 9 to avoid or to hold back from doing something


DOWN

- 8 the things that are happening at a certain moment


DOWN

- 10 a very large ocean wave


DOWN

- 9 holy or having to do with religion


DOWN

- 8** gave something useful or necessary


DOWN

- 9** the power to work


DOWN

- 8 not aware


DOWN

- 4** specific features that make a thing what it is
- 6** light, soft, feathery pieces
- 8** a shell or covering, often with seeds inside
