Building Automaticity is Critical

- Students need automatic word recognition skills in order to develop fluency, an essential skill for comprehension
- Students who have not developed automaticity in single word reading by the beginning of second grade are at risk for reading failure



Purpose of Word Warm-ups Live

- Reinforce phonemic awareness and phonics
- Develop mastery and automaticity in decoding
 - Progressing from single syllable words through multisyllabic words
- Support fluency development






- Consider a student's phonics needs



Word Warm-ups 2 Yellow Exercises

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- Level 1 is appropriate for 1st-8th grade needing support on phonics skills in the 1st-2nd grade range
 - Tier 1: independent practice (10 minutes daily)
 - Tiers 2 & 3: intervention (20-30 minutes daily)





There are 69 exercises in nine sections:

- Letter sounds
- Short vowels
- Long vowels with silent e
- Long vowels
- Digraphs
- Blends
- Vowels with the consonant r
- Other consonant sounds
- Other vowel sounds





Each section in a level has five types of exercises:

- Introduction
- Word List Lessons
- Review
- Story
- Challenge





Word List exercises include these steps:

Story exercises include these steps:

- Read Along
- Practice Story
- Quick Quiz
- Pass

- 5. Prepare students to use








Graph of Pass Score










