Let's play...

BANG!

What do I need?

Container to place cards into (bucket or jar)

Print and cut out two copies of one of the following sets of skill-practice cards (select the set of cards you want your students to practice the most):

- Upper and Lower-Case Letter Cards
- Number Cards
- Shape Cards
- Sight Word Cards

Print and cut out the following set of cards:

Bang Cards

How do I play?

- 1. Gather into a small group with your students.
- 2. Place all cards (the skill-practice cards and the Bang cards) into a container. Depending on the group size, you can add or subtract Bang Cards to fit the number of kids.
- 3. Set a timer for how long you want to play.
- 4. Pass the container around and have each student pull out one card at a time.
- 5. Ask the student to identify the card. If the student identifies the card correctly, they get to keep the card.
- 6. If they do not correctly identify the card, they can ask for two choices by saying, "Two choices please." You can then give the student a choice between two ways to identify the card (for example, "Is this P or B?"). If the student is correct, they get to keep the card. If not, the student must place the card back in the container.
- 7. If a student pulls out a Bang Card, they must put all their cards back into the container.
- 8. When the time is up, the student with the most cards wins.
