### Let's play...

# LAST ONE STANDING

### What do I need?

• No materials are needed for this game.

## How do I play?

- 1. Gather into a small group with your students.
- 2. Ask the students to stand up.
- 3. Say to the students, "We are going to say the ABCs in order starting with A."
- 4. The teacher says "A," and the student to their left says "B," then the next student says "C," and so on until you reach "Z."
- 5. The student who says, "Z," sits down and the game begins again.
- 6. The game continues until there are two players remaining and they play against one another for the final round.
- 7. The last person standing is the winner.

#### **Variations**

- Once the students know their letter names, you can play this game by having them say the letter names and sounds together ("A says /ă/, B says /b/") until they get to Z.
- You can also play with numbers and count up or down to a certain number, or count by twos, fives, tens, etc.
