

Beginning Readers

Exception if below range on level 1.0

May still work in Read Naturally if:

Recognizes 50 written words

Knows beginning sounds

Placement testing level	Scores in this range indicate a potential fit	
1.0 to 3.0	30 to 60 wcpm	
3.5 to 5.0	60 to 80 wcpm	
5.6 to 7.0	80 to 100 wcpm	
8.0	100 to 140 wcpm

Click the story you want to read.



2. Key Words

Click to learn the key words.



3. Prediction

Predict what the story will be



4. Cold Timing

Time yourself reading, and then view the graph.



5. Read Along

Read along with the narrator.



6. Practice

Practice reading on your own.



7. Quiz

Answer the quiz questions.



8. Retell/Word List

Retell the story or practice reading words from a phonics lesson.



9. Pass

Read the story to your teacher, and then view the results together.


Abrir Read Naturally

Adaptations for Distance Learning

- Setting up parents as Assistants
- Screen sharing and remote control
- Adjusting story options
- Options for pass activities
- Monitoring student progress
- Communicating with parents



Read Live Assistant

- Assistant role allows for flexibility in administering program by providing limited access to parent or other adult
- Assistant can:
 - Conduct cold timings and pass activities
 - Review student work
 - Reset story
 - Print stories
 - Print awards



Sharing and Controlling Screens

- If parents are unable to act as Assistants, you can use apps to share or control screens on student devices
 - Useful for placement, conducting cold timings and pass activities, student support
- Requires planning, setup, and training
- Many free or low-cost apps
 - Zoom, Google Meet, MS Teams

Adjust Story Options

- Allow student to perform cold timing without requiring teacher or parent to be present.
- Access from Staff or Student modules.
- Make other adjustments as necessary.
 For example:
 - Adjust time or remove requirements for prediction and/or retell
 - Add Spanish read along for some students



Pass Activities

- Perform hot timing
 - Start timing
 - Count missed words
 - Assess expression
- Review open-ended quiz questions
- Review retell
- Word list timing (Phonics series only)
- Review work with student
- Conduct remedial actions



Options for Pass Activities

- Parent as Assistant can perform Pass
- Teacher can use remote control to conduct Pass (student must share screen and grant access)
- If remote control is not possible login to student account and share your screen
- Student can record timing and send to teacher for evaluation and scoring
- See our Knowledgebase for details



School-to-Home Communication Tools

- Email or print and mail
 - Welcome letter
 - Progress letter
 - Certificates and awards
 - Copy of story
 - Story details report
- Use Zoom or Google Meet to demo Read Live or share reports
- Record student session



Monitoring Student Performance

Use student data to:

- Check the student's initial placement after three stories.
- Keep the student challenged over time.





Monitoring Student Performance

Indicators for Increasing Challenge

Consider making a change if a student meets two or more of the following indicators:

- Average cold-timing score improves.
- Average hot-timing score improves.
- Average quiz score improves.
- Average hot-timing score exceeds goal by ten or more.
- Average number of practices decreases.
- Student behavior changes.

- Word Warm-ups Live
 - Differentiated support for students who need additional phonics instruction


