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Read Live and Distance Learning

- Web-based, multi-device, offline support
- New features, including Login As, Hot Timing Recording, and Waiting List
- Most steps completed independently
- Customizable, supports differentiation
- School-to-home tools and support
- Up-to-date how-to's and training



Distance Learning Features

- Assistant role and Team function allows parents or aides to assist teachers with remote learning
- Asynchronous scoring with student recording of pass timings
- Login as student for screen sharing
- Real-time student progress and engagement indicators (Waiting List, current step, more...)
- Customizable lesson settings
- Parent communication tools

Conducting Pass Activities



What Are Pass Activities?

- Perform hot timing
 - Start timing
 - Count missed words
 - Assess expression
- Review open-ended quiz questions
- Review retell
- Word list timing (Phonics series only)
- Review work with student
- Conduct remedial actions



Options for Pass Activities

1. Parent performs pass activities
2. Student completes most steps at home, pass activities in classroom (hybrid)
3. Teacher uses remote control to conduct pass activities
4. If remote control not possible, log in as student and share your screen
5. Student records audio of themselves reading passage and shares with teacher



General Steps

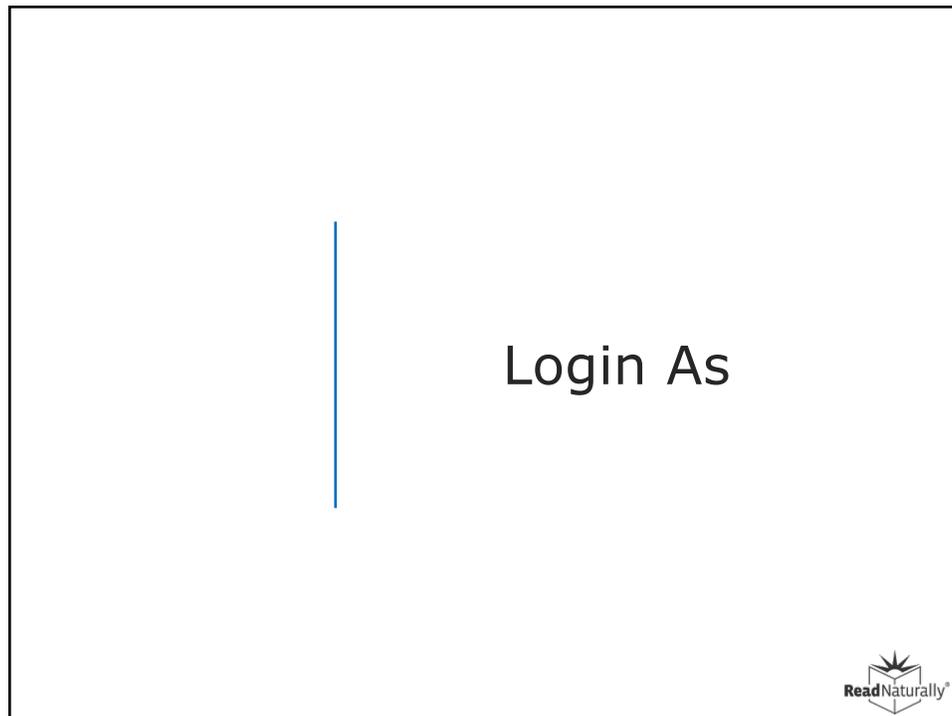
1. Start session with one or more students.
2. If you are working with multiple students, put each in separate breakout rooms (Zoom/Google Meet), use concurrent meetings (Google Meet), use channels (MS Teams) or ask students to mute themselves and others until they work with teacher.
3. Agree on a method for student to indicate they are ready for timing or that they need assistance (e.g., chat, raised hand, etc.).
4. Request control of student screen (if possible), OR;
5. Log in as student and share screen with them.
6. Perform timing or provide other supports.
7. When timing or pass activities are complete, relinquish control over student screen.

Login As

- Use when not possible or inconvenient to control student's screen (e.g., screen sharing tool or device does not support)
- Logs student out and logs teacher into student's session to more easily conduct timings during screen sharing
- Tip: remember to log out of student session so student can login again

Waiting List



Waiting List

- Lists all students in school waiting for teacher to monitor cold and hot timing
- Refresh screen to display most recent student activity
- Displays whether student has recorded hot timing (story and word list)
- Tip: Current Story Details report shows steps student has already completed



Hot Timing Recording and Scoring



Hot Timing Recording

- Student can record hot timing for story and word list (Phonics)
- Access at Pass/More Practice screen
- Students can review and re-record before saving recording
- Feature can be turned off by teacher or account admin
- Not supported on iPads and some browsers



Hot Timing Scoring

- Waiting List displays whether a recording has been saved by a student
- When logging in to conduct Pass activities, teacher has option to score hot timing asynchronously using recording (Score Recording) or while student is present (Start Live Timing)
- Proceed to a screen that does not require teacher to be present if you want student to work independently next time they login

Adjusting Story Options



Adjust Story Options

- Allow student to perform Cold Timing without requiring teacher or parent to be present
- Access from Staff or Student modules
- Make other adjustments as necessary. For example:
 - Adjust time or remove requirements for prediction and/or retell
 - Add Spanish read along for some students

Parents as Assistants



Parents as Assistants

- Do not give parents your password
- Account admin or school coordinator can create a Read Live Assistant
- Assistants can conduct timings and choose remedial actions, but can't view or modify student data
- Assistant can be added to lead teacher's Team
- Provide training, discuss expectations



What Can Assistants Do?

- From within the Student module:
 - Conduct cold timings and pass activities
 - Review student work; reset story, print stories and awards
