About Read Naturally Encore

Encore is the latest edition of the fluency program using blackline masters with audio support on CDs. Encore retains all the steps of the original edition, but adds more **instructional features** that make the program even better. Only the Sequenced and Phonics series are in the new format so far. **The Encore Placement Packet can be used with all series.**

Like the original edition, Read Naturally Encore develops fluency, supports vocabulary, and promotes comprehension through the powerful, research-based Read Naturally strategy. Read Naturally Encore enables a student to work on fluency at his or her own pace and in the appropriate level of material. A student masters each story by reading along with a recording of a fluent reader and then practicing the story until the student is able to reach a predetermined goal. The student gains confidence by tracking the increase in fluency rate from the initial reading to the final reading of each story, the scores on comprehension questions, and the words used in retelling or summarizing the story.
